

## Final Project Planning – Day 1

### Objectives:

- **Final Project** → For this project, use any tools that you choose to design and build a program that is *interactive* (the user determines what happens, i.e. they aren't watching a video).
  - **Development tools** –use your choice of tools to develop the program.
  - **Content** – the content is anything that you would like to create, *as long as*: **1)** programming code is used to allow the user to determine how the experience proceeds **2)** your program demonstrates skills that you learned this semester **3)** the program enhances the reputation of the Computer Magnet. As an example, this means that you cannot make a shooting game.

  - Complete the **Vision, Plan, Implement** sections.

## Final Project Planning – Day 2

### Objectives:

- Final Project → Plan **DUE TODAY!** at the end of class. **Worth 20 points.**
- Before turning in your plan, find another student to review your project plan. **Reviewer:** read the plan and make sure that it includes the following:
  - **Vision (3 pts)** – 1 to 3 sentence overview of the project. **Reviewer: after reading the vision, do you have a picture in your mind of the finished project?**
  - **Plan (4 pts)** –Task list (I will be paying close attention to the **task list**, create a table with a timeline, be detailed with the required tasks). **Reviewer: are all jobs included in the task list? Do the Due Dates extend from now until project completion? (A task should be finished every few days).**

- **Implement (4 pts)** – Materials and References. **Reviewer: are all materials included? Are all references included, like URL's of web sites that were used for graphics?**
- **Spell & Grammar Check (2 pts)** – No spelling or grammar errors.

- **Plan signed by reviewer (2 pts)** – reviewer should sign your plan after you have made corrections that they suggest.
