A **Senior Web Portfolio** will be posted on the CCT Magnet website by each student. The purpose of the portfolio is to display exemplary work you have created while in the program. Satisfactory completion of the Senior Portfolio is required to complete the CCT Magnet and receive a program certificate.

At a **minimum**, each senior portfolio will include a link to at least 1 project. For full points, you should create a website that serves as a gallery to show the best projects you have completed in the CCT Magnet. The plan is to leave the portfolios on the website for several years.

Students should prepare the following for the site:

- Picture
- Biography – ideas: CCTM classes completed, TJ activities, future plans
- Projects: include the file or web link
- Project descriptions

Pathways point value = 100 points

Rubric:

- Attractive site design
- Site follows design fundamentals
- Site is organized
- Effective user interface/navigation
- Graphics and pictures follow design fundamentals and enhance the site
- Excellent project work, no errors in the work
- The site reflects positively on TJ and the Center for Communication Technology Magnet
- Error free
- On-time

You can use any web technology you choose to develop the site. Examples include: Dreamweaver, Flash, Wordpress, Wiki. If you have a different tool you would prefer to use, check with Mr. Fornstrom before you begin.
